
CELLAR SELECTION 2012 PINOT NOIR

TASTING NOTES

Dark, deep ruby-red colour, with slight purple hues, lighter on rim. This has a firmly concentrated and tight bouquet of aromatic black cherry and dark red berry fruit, complexed by subtle nuances of thyme herb, liquorice and spicy oak, unfolding violetty perfumes with aeration. Medium-full bodied, the fruit flavours are vibrant and succulent, and well-concentrated with a firm core of red berry and dark cherry fruit, thyme herb, savoury whole cluster perfumes and violet florals. The extraction is significant, with very fine-grained, powdery tannins supporting the fruit alongside bright, lacy, lively acidity enhancing the fruit sweetness. The palate features a firm and linear, driven core that carries the wine to a very long and sustained finish with cherry and herb elements. This is an elegant and firmly concentrated Pinot Noir with vibrant and succulent dark cherry fruit in the Bendigo style. Match with lamb, beef and venison.
